Jackpot information

The current format and prize money for the day will remain the same.

Cost: The cost per bowler for bowls will be **\$14 (including Green Fees of \$12 and \$2 for the Jackpot)**.

<u>Jackpots</u>

How the jackpots will work:

There will be two (2) jackpots pools; one (1) for <u>Plus Margins</u> and one (1) for <u>Minus Margins</u>. \$2 from each bowler; half will go into each of the <u>Plus</u> <u>Margins</u> and <u>Minus Margins</u> pool. (Example: 48 bowlers; \$48 goes to the <u>Plus Margins</u> Pool and \$48 goes to the <u>Minus Margins</u> Pool)

The <u>Plus Margin</u> and <u>Minus Margin</u> jackpots are based on the total team margins for the day. (Positive (+) margins go into the <u>Plus Margins</u> pool & negative (-) margins into the <u>Minus Margin</u> pool)

The Margins will range from 0 to +30 for the <u>Plus Margins</u> and –1 to -30 for the <u>Minus Margins</u>. (If a team has a margin outside this range (**greater than +/– 30**), they will get to choose a margin before the draw takes place)

Each of the jackpots will be drawn separately.

If there is no <u>Plus Margin</u> winner or <u>Minus Margins</u> winner on the day, that Margins pool will jackpot to the next week. (When either of the jackpots reaches **\$300**, then that amount will remain until won. A new jackpot pool will commence for the next pool, but will not be available until previous jackpot is won.)

If there are two (2) or more teams with the same drawn margin (Plus or Minus Margins), then the jackpot money is to be divided equally between those teams.

Score Cards and the Results Board must be filled out correctly.

One (1) member of the team must be present to collect the Jackpot.
