Caboolture Lakes Bowls Club Inc Policy 2/2013 Club Uniform Policy

The appropriate clothing to be worn for bowlers representing Caboolture Lakes Bowls Club Inc (CLBC) in CDBA, CDBLA, Bowls Queensland, Bowls Australia or any other form of competition, must meet the Attire Conditions of Play for that event.

In Club Championship and Club Certified Competitions all players must be dressed in the correct attire to comply with Bowls Queensland By-Laws and CLBC Conditions of Play.

In the interest of sun safety, Caboolture Lakes Bowls Club strongly recommends the wearing of suitable protective clothing appropriate for the Queensland climate.

Flat-soled footwear with the design and colour to be the choice of the bowler is to be worn during competition or social events.

Club uniform is to be worn on Ladies (Wednesday's) social bowling days.

Club uniform, or approved Bowls Australia attire, is to be worn on Men's (Saturday) social bowling days.

Club uniform is to be worn on all club organized visits, in or out, by Caboolture Lakes Bowls Club members.

For social bowls competitions, smart casual wear is to be worn; no singlet tops or work clothes will be allowed.
